The following operations are not required to register:

- establishments already approved or registered under Regulation (EC) No. 852/2004 or Regulation (EC) No. 853/2004
- activities involving the generation of animal by-products on site only, which are carried out on farm or other premises where animals are kept, bred or taken care of
- establishments or plants that require approval under Article 24 of Regulation (EC) No. 1069/2009 or any
 activity associated with that establishment e.g. transport of ABPs. These operations including rendering,
 incineration, combustion, pet food plants, manufacturers of organic fertilisers and soil improvers, compost
 and biogas plants, plants handling and storing animal by-products or products derived from animal byproducts must apply for approval. Application forms are available on GOV.UK
