Ideal for:

Skip and hooklift (must be bagged)



- Asbestos roof sheets
- Asbestos tiles
- Asbestos concrete
- Asbestos insulation

Dry mixed recycling

We call it: Dry mixed recycling

You may call it: • Co-mingled

MDR (mixed dry recycling)

Ideal for: Trade and REL





Materials we <u>can</u> accept

- Dry paper office paper and newspapers and magazines, envelopes (windows OK)
- Wrapping paper (if scrunches)
- Books
- Dry cardboard (grey or brown)
- Cans (including empty aerosols)
- Plastic bottles (up to 5 litres) PET (clear), HDPE (milk bottles)
- Pots, tubs and trays (HIPS yoghurt pots, PP clean food packaging)



Materials we cannot accept under this classification

Food waste

We call it:	Food waste
You may call it:	 ABP Cat 3 - not for human consumption Kitchen waste Canteen waste
Ideal for:	Trade bins (food waste specific up to 240 litre)



Materials we can accept

- Commercially produced kitchen and canteen waste
- Products or foods originally for human consumption
- Plastic, paper and cardboard food packaging
- Domestic catering waste



Materials we cannot accept under this classification

Please contact us if you have any of these waste streams so that we can advise you of the correct classification and the type of container / service you require

- Black bag waste
- Metals including cans, knives and forks
- Glass tins
- Hazardous waste such as chemicals, fridges, waste oils and batteries
- Construction, demolition and inert wastes
- Category 1 or 2 animal by-products food waste, e.g. slaughter house waste
- Food waste not fit for human consumption

Garden waste

We call it:	Green waste and compost
You may call it:	• Compost
Ideal for:	Skips and hooklift containers



Materials we can accept

- Plant tissue
- Grass cuttings
- Branches, tree trunks etc; (**must not** exceed 150mm diameter, and 3m length)
- Chipped trees and shrubs



Materials we cannot accept under this classification

- Food waste including fruit, vegetables, coffee grounds, egg shells, meat
- Treated wood
- Street sweeping waste


